HIKE THE VINE TRAIL (ROOM)

Move through vineyards, olive groves and pines, and cross-rivers to discover antiquities in the wilderness of the valley. Starting with a visit to the Roum Village Square, the St. George church and the Nabi Yaacoub Mosque, you will hike your way to the Dagon forest, passing Rihane bushes. Make your way through a glorious array of wild lavender, pink anemones and cyclamen that lead you through oaks and a rock cave to reach the Qattine River and the incredible view of the Qattine Valley.

SAYDET EL MAABOUR – SOUK EL SEDD

It is a great sport to take beautiful panoramic pictures. Meticulously sculpted by Youssef Ghossoub, the Statue of the Virgin Mary stands at the west entrance of Jezzine overlooking the villages of Bkassine, Wadi Jezzine, the Bkassine Pine Forest and the waterfall. Its religious significance and cultural icon has become a key point in the region with vast natural landscapes surrounding it. In her hand, the Virgin Mary holds the key of the town of Jezzine.
