

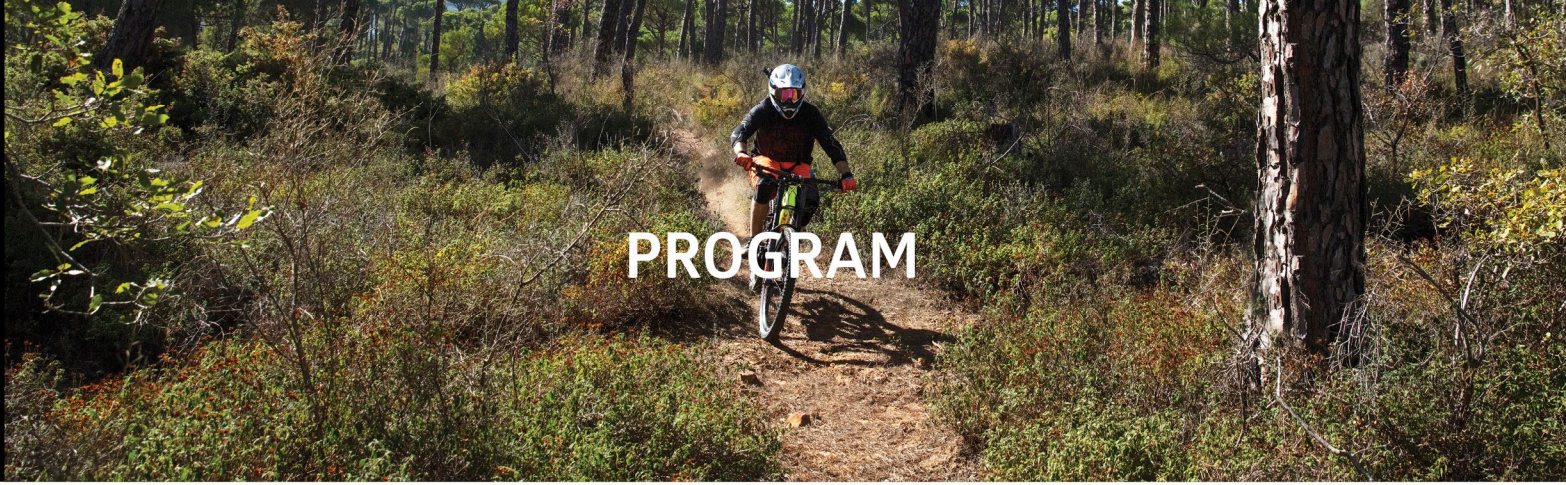

AASFOURIYET EL JANNE (ROMMANE)

This unique museum is located in the small-uninhabited region of Rommaneh. It is the work of one man, Sami Harfouche, who has passionately put it all together throughout the years. The collection includes around 300 original pieces, some of which are rare to find. It includes equipment and tools used by the different professions, a collection of ancient household objects, and a lot of agriculture related items.
