This incredible trail leads you through beautiful villages while experiencing stunning 360° views of the region. This trail begins at the Municipality of **Jezzine**, a remarkable building dating back to 1898. Take a stroll through the **Souk el Sedd** which features some charming traditional stores where you can pick up artisan bread and dried fruits. Head up an asphalt road for 1 km until you reach the top of the Ain Toughra hill for a splendid panoramic 360° view of **Jezzine, Mount Hermon and Mount Sannine**.



Head south, passing an imposing cross monument, through dramatic rock formations to view the village of **Haytoura** in the valley below. Continue on the track road, then head into the wild to take a trail which leads to a massive oak tree under a cliff with a wooden cross – a great spot to take a rest in the shade. Continue through the challenging rough terrain to reach the **Haytoura** village stairs. Visit **St Anthony Church**, the village water fountain, and remnants of the Vichy occupation, then head to the Cafe Cheer for a refreshing drink and a snack.



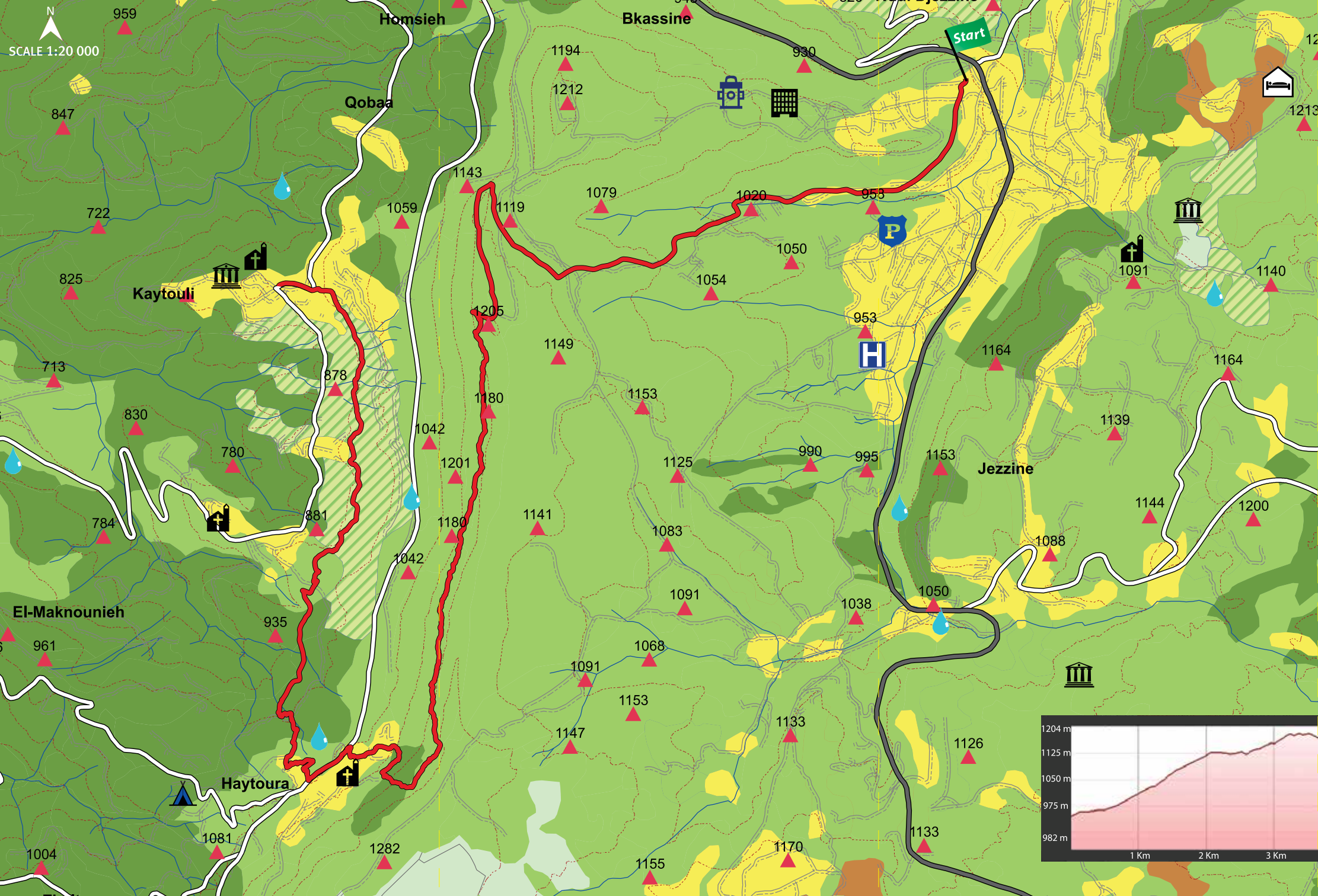
From here walk towards the valley, head through the olive groves and grazing cattle, passing a pine forest. Continue east on a stony trail towards the village of **Kaytoui** through a meadow, in spring a blanket of wildflowers. Then through the trees to reach an asphalt road, take a right to a gravel road until it splits. Head up on a stony mountain path, along a fence, then head down to pass over the El Jouze stream, through an olive grove. Take a right to reach the El Rabiha stream.



Make your way through the ferns and scrubs to reach towering pine trees and continue right to reach an asphalt road which will take you to a restaurant in the woods offering local delicacies, a lovely spot for lunch. Continue to the village of **Kaytoui** to visit the village fountain, the **St Michael Church** and the **St George Church**. Admire the panoramic view from the courtyard and take a stroll through this charming village featuring traditional houses. End your hike here or continue hiking on **The Kaytoui Coal Mine Trail**.
