09.00 – 12.00:

HIKING THE COAL MINE TRAIL - KAYTOULI

Travel through the peaceful nature with breathtaking views to discover hidden historical sites. It begins at Kaytouli village, moving through the Homsiyeh village before going down to the Mar Gerges stream that passes through a jungle of brilliant green Kateaa Wasel, a fauna unique to this region. Take a break at the refreshing ice-cold spring then head towards the Al Wata Valley, blanketed with wild flowers near an ancient mill and abandoned stone houses.

12.00 – 14.30:

VISIT KARAM WINERY/ LUNCH OR RESTAURANT OF YOUR CHOICE

From the Highlands of Jezzine where vineyards have been planted years before the Romans came to Lebanon, up there at an altitude of 1300m, Karam wines was born. Before Karam Wines came into being, all Lebanese wines were made of grapes grown in the Bekaa Valley. During your stop, you will taste their award-winning wines on top of a hill while enjoying a breathtaking scenery and some fresh air! Visits can include lunch and tasting courses with prior notice. VISIT THE FARID SERHAL PALACE

Cross the gates of the Farid Serhal Palace and witness an ancient moment of the region with a philosophical stone book, a celebration of beauty, a hymn to life, and a salute to history. Here lies the unachieved dream of Dr. Farid Serhal, a member of the parliament who once had an inspiring vision.
